

Configure Analyzer Data Source Visibility

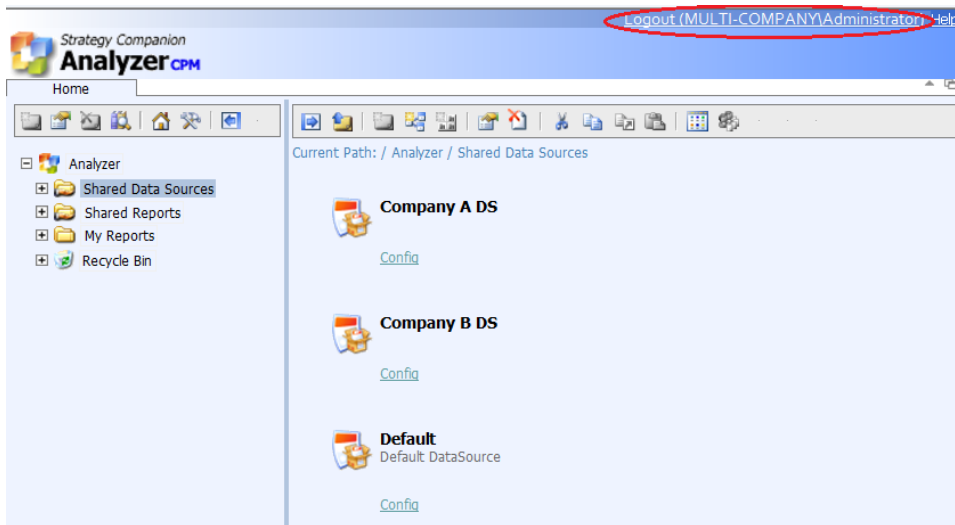
Background

In a Multi-Company version of Analyzer (also referred to as Analyzer SaaS), there may be multiple data source objects defined; although, not all of them should be made available to the user of a sub-company. This document contains step-by-step instructions to illustrate how this can be done.

Test Environment

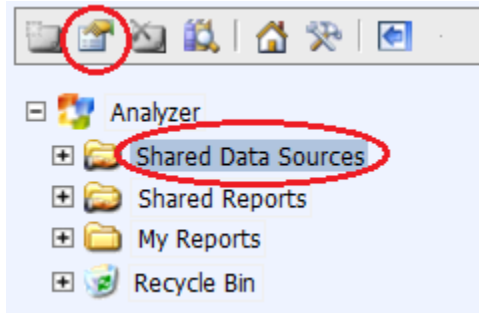
Three users: Local machine administrator (also a Host Administrator)
 CompanyAAdministrator – Company A’s Administrator
 UserA1 – Company A’s End User

Create a new Analyzer role: “Company A Role”
Create three (3) Data Source Objects like the ones you see below:

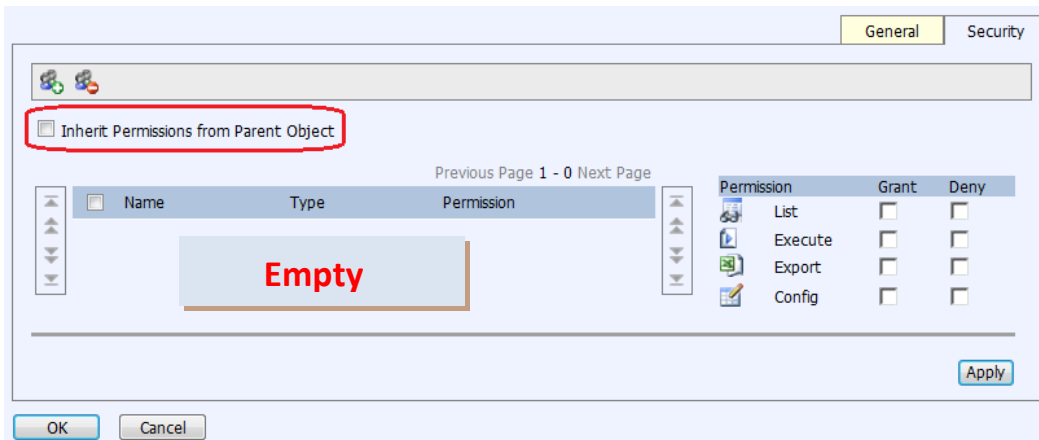


Example Setup Steps

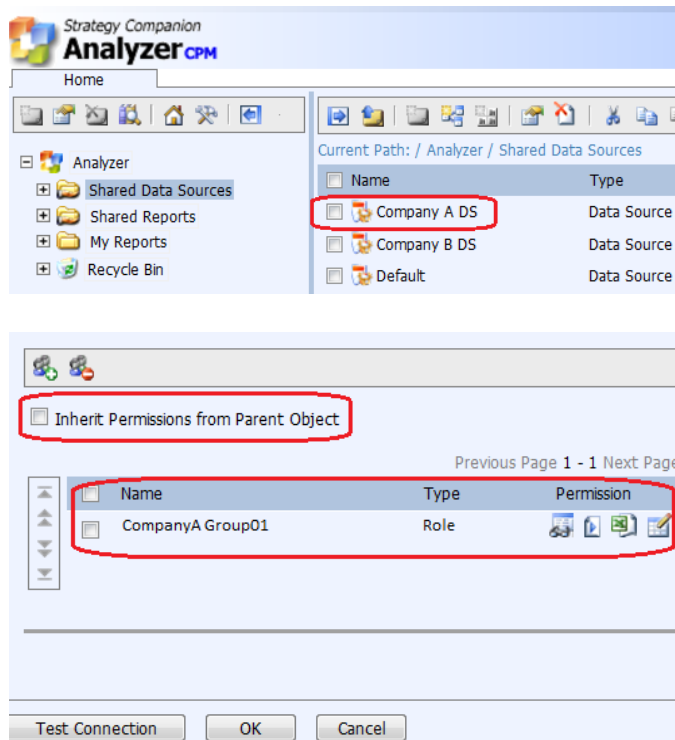
1. First, remove the **Shared Data Sources** privilege.



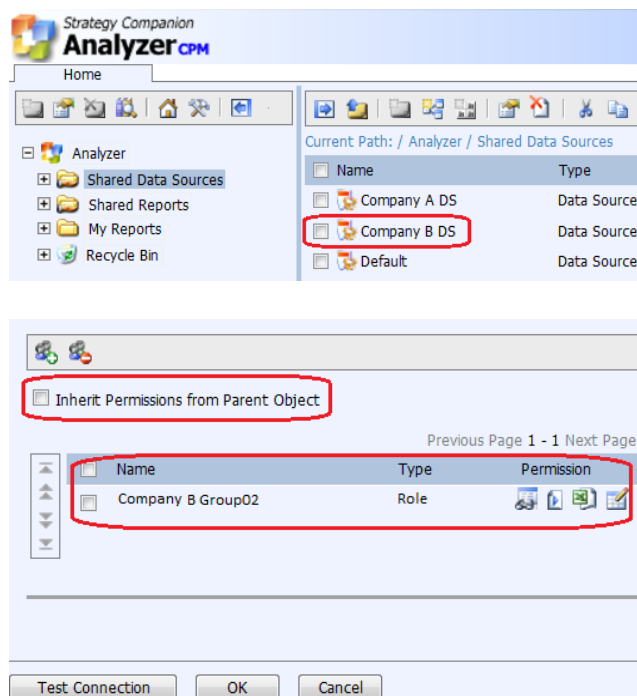
Remove the “**Inherit**” checkbox.

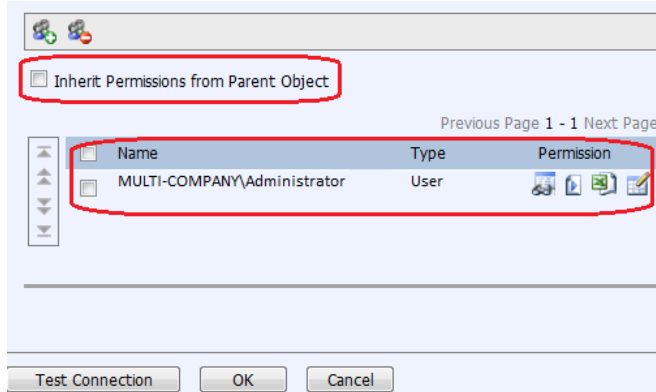
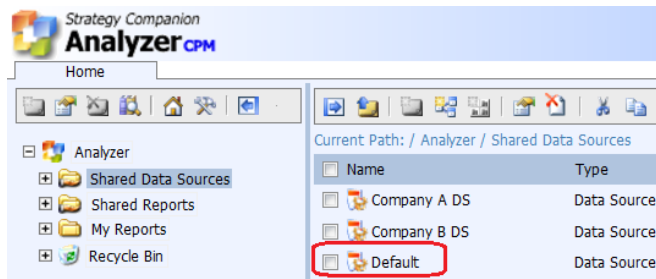


- Grant the DataSource object “Company A DS” to “Company A Group01”.

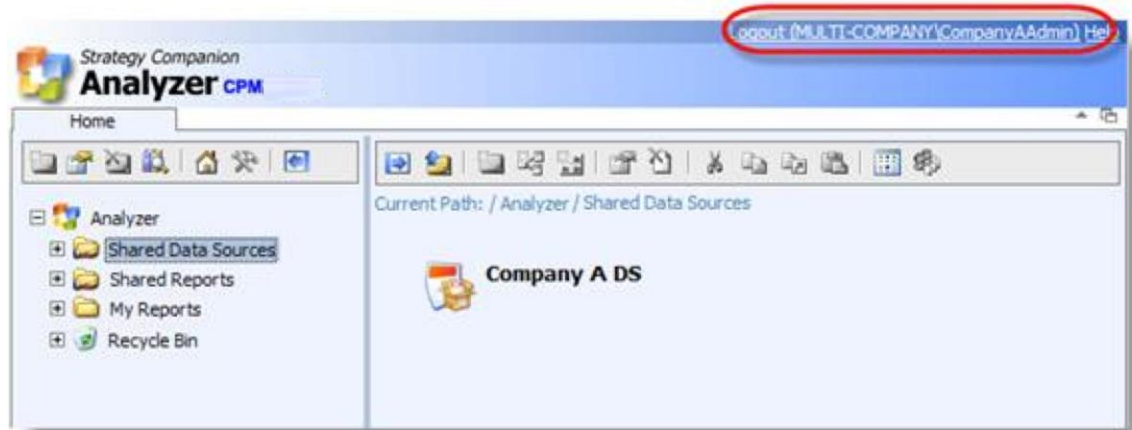


- Next, grant the other DataSource objects to their respective company role

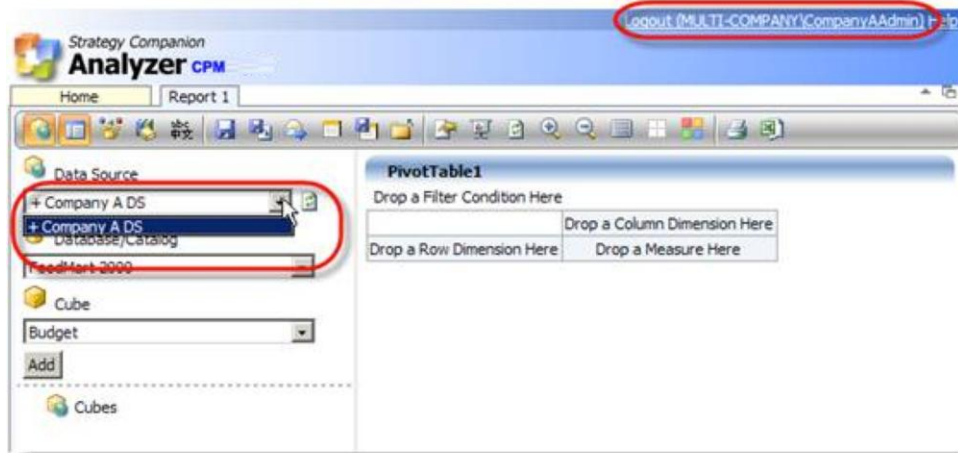




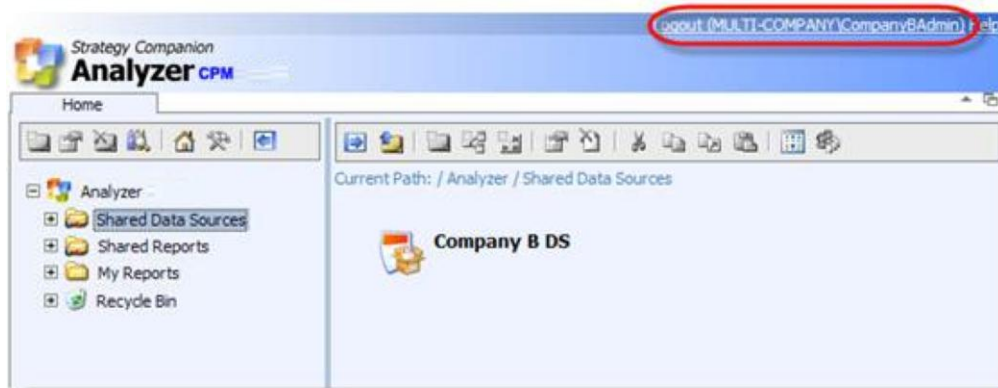
- Now login using the **CompanyAAdmin** account. You should only see **“Company A DS”**



5. Also, if you create a new report, you will see just one data source: “**Company A DS**”



6. Now login using **Company B Admin**. Only “**Company B DS**” can be seen.



7. Create a new report. Only “**Company B DS**” is available.
