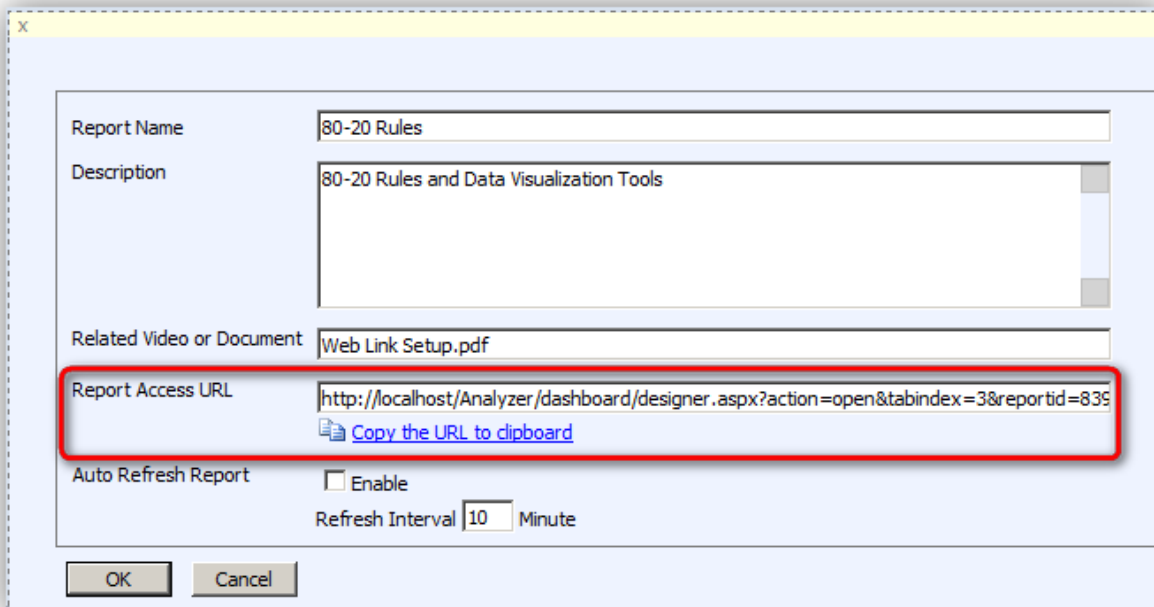
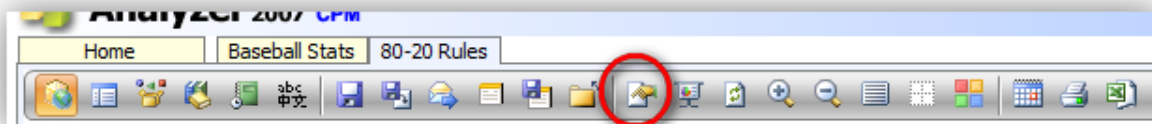


Obtaining Direct Report URL

Background

Every Analyzer report has a direct report URL so the report can be opened directly. Normally this link can be obtained through Analyzer's standard user interface by clicking the **Properties...** button on the toolbar then copy the **Report Access URL**.



An alternative way to obtain this information directly from the database is illustrated here by this document.

Steps

1. First to understand what's in the URL, we use the following URL as example:

<http://localhost/Analyzer/dashboard/designer.aspx?action=open&tabindex=2&reportid=1115124110&folderid=1281595708&token=WUFBQUFnQUFBQXc2dXRlY1VMOTkKsZBtVzZlUHRhQWdiUkk1bm5XRFlvV3NzaytkbzdHejU4Zw==>

Two most important piece of information in the URL are the **reportid** and **folderid**. As long as we know a report's **reportid** and **folderid**, we can then access this report from a URL. All these necessary information are stored in Analyzer's system database **dbo.Reports** table, so one can easily retrieve this information by using SQL queries – for example using the query below to retrieve any report's **reportid** and **folderid**:

SELECT reportid, folderid FROM dbo.Reports WHERE ReportName LIKE "%baseball%"

Result:

	ReportId	FolderId
▶	-1333755501	624687020
*	NULL	NULL

Then you can simply substitute the **reportid** and **folderid** to the same URL string
